Highland Court Has Violated a Treatment Technique

Our water system recently violated a drinking water standard. Although this was not an emergency, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened, what you should do, and what we are doing to correct this situation.

We routinely monitor your water for the presence of drinking water contaminants. Testing results we received on during 2019 _____ show that our system exceeds the standard for Lead _____. The standard for solving this issue is submitting a corrosion control treatment permit application. Highland Court was required to submit a permit application within 30 month of this exceedance. _____ was found at _____.

What should I do?

- **You do not need to use an alternative (i.e., bottled water) water supply.** However, if you have specific health concerns, consult your doctor.

What does this mean?

- This is not an immediate risk. If it had been, you would have been notified immediately. However, _____.

Highland Court failed to submit a permit application for optimal corrosion control treatment within 30 months of the first action level exceedance. We anticipate resolving the problem within three (3) to six (6) months pending required permits and approvals. _____.
